9. CONDITIONS OF STAY

During their stay in Croatia, all missions will be guests of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Croatia from time of their arrival until their departure. Normal board and lodging are at the expense of the organizing country from August 10 – 17, 2009. Extra expenses must be paid by the individual consumer. Outside the period August 10 – 17, missions will be responsible for all expenses. The missions are restricted in number as authorized by CISM Regulations. Accompanying persons should be prepared to pay their own hotel accommodation. The organizer will help and provide reservations if requested.

10. PASSPORTS, VISAS, HEALTH REGULATIONS

For information on requirements, please contact the nearest Embassy of the Republic of Croatia.

The organizer will take care of medical support (first aid service) at the competition site. A doctor and an ambulance will be available in order to provide first aid service. The infirmary at the Croatian military academy will provide medical service round the clock.

Participants' health insurance must be valid in Croatia.

The Organizing Committee is NOT responsible for:

- Hospitalizations,*
- Surgical operations or other special treatments,*
- Repatriation in case of decease by illness or accident,*
- Other expenses on account of illness/accident such as compensations, loss of income, etc.*
